Thank you for your letter received this morning and we are pleased to note that you have been able to arrange for a labourer to assist our bellhanger.

As to how long our bellhanger will require lodgings, this will be anything from a week to ten days or so but in any case there should be no doubt whatever about him being finished before June 26th. In due course we shall be despatching some tackle for use in connection with removing the bells etc. from the tower, this tackle will consist of boxes of chain blocks and timbers, etc. and we hope it will be possible for these to be placed under safe and dry cover pending our bellhanger's arrival on Monday, June 14th. We cannot give you any idea of the date when the goods will arrive as this will depend upon the time that our local depot of British Road Services has a lorry coming near Bolton.
