
Deane Church - Bells.

Thank you for your letter of the 24th inst. and we note you will be sending us the inscriptions for the bells in the near future. It is usual in bells as old as 1718 to reproduce the lettering in facsimile but in the case of modern bells which are being recast the lettering is not usually reproduced exactly. Of course there is no reason why all the letters should not be of different type to the original if it be so desired.

We usually use Roman capitals as shown on the enclosed photo postcard and we do not think there could be any criticism of this lettering as it is supposed to be very good.
