Your letter addressed to Mr. W.W. Tong has been handed to us and we note the preparations you require in the walls of the tower to accommodate the girders carrying the bells.

We note that the steel girders are embedded solidly in the existing rubble walls and presume that there will be no vibration transmitted to the old rubble walls from the framework, and if any dampering pads are required under the girders, perhaps you would let us know.

We have assumed that the girders will be supplied by you and that we have only to arrange for the holes as indicated on your drawing.
