
Deane Church - Bells.

Thank you for your letter of the 30th October and we have made it clear to your Architects that the girders for the bellframe will be supplied and hoisted by us and it is only the preparation of the holes in the walls of the bellchamber which we require carrying out locally and then making good after the girders have been placed in position by our men.

We wrote to Messrs. Bradshaw, Gass & Hope yesterday advising them that we hope to commence installing the new bellframe and the bells on Monday, December 6th, and we enquired if we could depend upon the holes in the bellchamber being ready by that date. If so our work in the tower will be finished by Christmas. On the assumption that we can plan in accordance with the foregoing will you please arrange lodgings and local help for our bellhanger as you so kindly did before but for a period of a fortnight or so this time.
