**Crest.**—An eagle's head erased, proper, *Fyfe*.

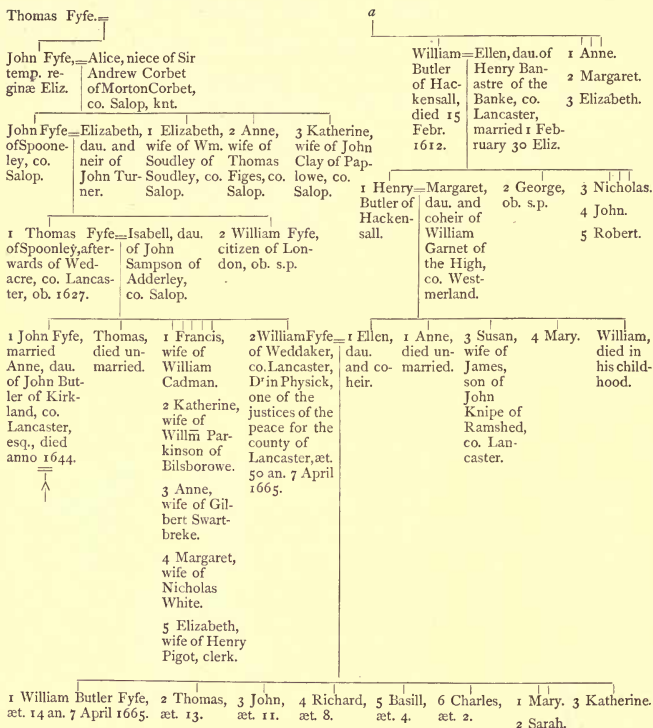
On an escutcheon of pretence over the arms: Azure, a chevron between three covered cups, or, *Butler*.

By a note annexed to the arms it appears that the family of Fyfe were of Kennaway in Scotland, in the reign of king William in anno 1175, and the arms were "extracted for the use of Maister Willm Fyfe, Gentleman, 12 Sept. 1643," by the Scotch officers of arms.
