By a note annexed to the arms it appears that the family of Fyfe were of Kennaway in Scotland, in the reign of king William in anno 1175, and the arms were "extracted for the use of Maister Willim Fyfe, Gentleman, 12 Sept. 1643," by the Scotlon Givers of arms.
